

Acceptable Tuberculosis Screenings

You are responsible for covering the cost of this medical screening.

PPD Skin Test

This is the gold standard and preferred screening. We recommend your Primary Care Provider first. If they are not able to do this, your next best option is an urgent care facility. We highly discourage going to a pharmacy such as CVS or Walgreens as they tend to be considerably more expensive. With any of these options, you must return 48-72 hours later to have the test read.

Quantiferon TB GOLD

This is a blood test to screen for tuberculosis. This should only be used if you have been told not to do the PPD Skin test. Your primary care physician or an urgent care facility are your best options.

Chest X-Ray

If you have been told not to do the PPD Skin Test or the Quantiferon TB GOLD, we will need documentation of a recent Chest X-ray and completion of an 8 question survey. If you have already provided documentation of the Chest X Ray, you must complete the 8 question survey on an annual basis. Please contact us with any questions.
